Handgun shooters may join the **Community Pistol League (C.P.L.)** on Wednesdays. Their regular season starts Wed., 9/08/2021. The first relay starts between 4:00 and 4:30pm and the last relay ends by 7:00 or 8:00pm (depending on how many shooters). You do not need to be a member of the RRC to participate in that league but you must have a valid NYS Pistol permit and sign a waiver. 1. Our leagues will continue to social distance (shoot on every other firing point) and sanitize.
2. Just a reminder that the RRC Board of Directors currently allows a member to bring in a guest, but each guest must be continuously supervised by a current member , only one at a time. This means the member and guest take turns shooting. The guest signs the guest log and a waiver prior to using the range.
3. During open shooting, handgun shooters may fire at the 33feet (10meter) carrier stop instead of 50feet on points 1 thru 4 only. See link on web-site homepage to current range rules and see signage.
