

New York State Mandated Pistol Permit Safety Course

The Rochester Rifle Club is pleased to announce that it will be holding the mandated pistol permit safety course that is required by NYS law for all applicants seeking a NY pistol permit. The course will be presented over two Saturdays – October 29 and November 5 from 8:00 AM until about 6:00 PM. The cost of the course is \$275.

Handguns, ammunition, and holsters will be provided for use in the class. Students must be 21 years old and must not have any legal prohibitions about handling firearms or ammunition.

Students should bring hearing and eye protection, although we will have a limited amount for those who do not have those items. Students should also bring a notebook and pen and a garment such as a jacket or button shirt that can be worn to cover a handgun in a holster. Also, please wear a belt that is sufficiently strong to be able to hold a holster and firearm.

We encourage students to bring lunch and other refreshments (no alcoholic beverages), as, although we will be taking short breaks during the course, we will not be breaking for lunch per se.

Class enrollment will be limited to about 8 participants, Interested persons are encourage to enroll as soon as possible as the slots will be filled on a first come-first served basis. Registration and payment-in-full must be received by October 15.
